

## *How does a skill become an "Official Skill"?*

- ✓ In order to become an "Official Skill," detailed paperwork must be submitted to the WorldSkills Technical Committee, which decides on the admission of new skills.
- ✓ If there is enough interest among member countries, the skill will be included in the next Competition as a "Demonstration Skill."
- ✓ If certain criteria are achieved, a Demonstration Skill can move ahead to be considered an Official Skill.
- ✓ The total number of skills and actual skill categories is determined by WorldSkills International.
- ✓ WSI aims to develop a complementary range of skills competitions within each of the six sectors.
- ✓ WSI endeavours to ensure that the skills at the Competitions reflect their mission, the Competition goals and are representative of the skill needs of the global economy.
- ✓ Any Member can reintroduce an Official Skill that failed to obtain the required support at the previous Competition, provided they follow published guidelines.
